- 9:00 Arrive at Lassen Volcanic National Park
All four types of volcanoes plus active geothermal areas are found as well as great fishing, hiking or canoeing.
- 9:30 Depart for Subway Caves
- 10:00 Arrive at Subway Caves for ½ hour hike
Voyage into volcanic history as you hike into a lava tube. Subway Cave is the largest accessible tube in the flow.
